Please pray for them to be able to settle in well and learn the foundations of their education. A solid education and the ability to think outside the box will help them have a good productive future.

Follow up - on the left are some of our miracle babies with before and after pictures. The top left picture is Asina and Sharifa just this week. These two came in at 11 months old, smaller than most newborns weighing 5lb 6oz and 5lb 8oz and struggling to survive their life of neglect because of a mentally ill mother and very aged father. They are making strides through some of their developmental delays. Please pray that their little brains function well so they can learn and have a good educational foundation.

I think that Doreen on the bottom left had Guardian Angels all around her when she was abandoned in a cane field right after birth and was found safe after 4 days. It is a miracle she is alive as there are birds of prey, huge rats, wild dogs, foxes and the hot sun.

In the right hand column are two of our children that your love and support in their early years made it possible for us to give them a hope and a future. They had no one able to care for them in their very early years and were adopted by a very caring family.

Thank you to all our adoptive families as you give a life of wonderful opportunity to our children in need.
