The young girl from last newsletter with much of her skull showing has been admitted to the home for 3 months of boosted nutrition and nursing care to look after her head wound. She is responding well to treatment and the tissue on the head is regenerating. Her young mum is expecting another child this month has also had her nutrition boosted so she has a healthy labor-delivery and baby.

Some of our children are struggling with the emotional pain of their abandonment. Would you please keep all the children's hearts in your prayers as it makes a big difference. They daily walk through emotional valleys that they don't understand and respond with a lot of anger.

For the most part all the children are healthy and growing well. They are becoming much better students at their new schools. Pray they settle well.

This past month we said our goodbyes to Jessica and Emma who went home to their villages. Also to Steven, John and Pauline who have been fostered by American family who are working in Uganda. Thank you to all our prayer and financial partners.
