This past month we have had a village medical clinic where we treated 614 patients, a mix of adults and children. Transportation showed as a need for the many handicapped children. Some were supplied jogging strollers, another a youth wheel chair and yet another hand pedaled one is ordered for a girl unable to walk at all. She has been crawling on the dusty or muddy ground to get around. Thanks to Travis and his medical funding team several much needed operations are happening each week for the needy of Lwambogo district. A big thanks to Dr Phillip and his team for the care.

We see lasting results in the children from all the child development work done at the home by volunteers and our staff this year. <u>Great job everyone</u>. The children at the home are much more peaceful. Sam one of our cooks is spending some much needed 'man time' with the children, singing, dancing, playing and taking them for bike rides.

Three wells are under construction at this time in Lwambogo and Kamigo to supply village and the children with clean drinking water. It will also save the children such a long walk to carry jerry cans.
