## Happy New Year to you all !!!

The Christmas and New Year celebrations for the children and staff include their favorite foods including roasted goat - enjoyed greatly by them all - and topped off with desserts & soda.

Our school children (about 40) were gifted with a trip to the Zoo in Entebbe to see the Animals. They had 11 mums with them for their bus ride on the main road through tea plantations, sugar cane, many villages, and Kampala City where there is lots of traffic to see as well as all the big buildings.

After receiving many questions about Ella from some of you, so I am including some pictures of her journey so far. She is the little village girl who was very sick with Malaria and had an IV in a vein on her head. The IV site became badly infected and she lost a lot of scalp tissue, thus exposing a large amount of skull bone. She was rescued by our village medical team and brought to Jinja for medical treatment and then with her parents and probation officers blessing was admitted to the home for her healing process. The picture center top shows how much tissue has regenerated. After it fills in completely she will have a skin graft. Once the graft heals she will return home to mum and dad and her new baby sister, and also the new garden her dad has developed with the help of our team for added nutrition. (All today's pix are of Ella) The rest of the children are doing well. We have three new babies who I will introduce next letter.
